

**BABE RUTH LEAGUE
CAL RIPKEN MINOR
2005 RULES
9 & 10 YEAR OLDS**

1. All games in this League will be governed under the 2004 Official Baseball Rules and 2004 CAL RIPKEN Division rules with the following exceptions:
2. All League games will have a time limit of one hour, thirty minutes (1:30) and/or five (5) innings. The 10-run rule will be in effect after two and one half (2 1/2) or three (3) innings. Pitching limit will be a total of five (5) innings per week per pitcher. Weeks will be designated on the official schedule.
3. This year's Cal Ripken Minor League will consist of seven (7) teams. Your league schedule will consist of playing sixteen 16 games. The first two (2) weeks of the schedule, four (4) games do not count toward league standings. You will play two (2) rounds of games (6) - one (1) against each team in the league. The round one champion will play the round two champion at the end of the season in the best two out of three playoff games to determine the overall league champion. If one team wins round one and round two they will be declared the overall league champion. The League champion will be decided by a 3-game playoff series (best 2 out of 3) between the East Division champion and the West Division champion. There will be **TWO** (2) all star teams picked from the League. One All Star Team with only 9 year olds to represent the league in the 9 Year Old District Tournament to be held in Donaldsonville, Louisiana. One All Star Team of 10 year olds will represent the league in the 10 Year Old District Tournament in New Roads, Louisiana. No 9 year olds will be allowed to play on the 10 Year Old Team, and no 10 year olds will be allowed on the 9 Year Old Team.
4. Division playoff will be held on June 17th and 18th, 2004.
5. Each player must play at least one (1) complete innings (6 outs) in each game, and bat at least once in every game.
EXCEPTION: 10-run rule game and /or Time Limit. In this case player must start next scheduled game.
6. All Star selection of players and coaches will be at the discretion of Iberville Parks & Recreation District.
7. League Tournament will be Saturday, June 5th, 2004 ... single elimination.
8. Anything not covered under the above rules will be decided by IPRD.

CAL RIPKEN MAJOR
2005 RULES
11 & 12 YEAR OLDS**

1. All games in this League will be governed under the 2004 Official Baseball Rules and 2004 CAL RIPKEN Division rules with the following exceptions:
2. All League games will have a time limit of one hour, forty five minutes (1:45) and/or six (6) innings. The 10-run rule will be in effect after three and one half (3 ½) or four (4) innings. Pitching limit will be a total of six (6) innings per week per pitcher. Weeks will be designated on the official schedule.
3. This year's CAL RIPKEN Major League will consist of eight (8) teams which will be split into two separate divisions - the East Division with four (4) teams and the West Division with four (4) teams. Games will consist of playing a total of sixteen (16) league games. Each team will play every other team two (2) times for the league title of each division. The division champion will be decided by the best won/loss record of sixteen (16) games total. Ties within the division will be decided by a one (1) game playoff, not head to head competition. The League champion will be decided by a 3-game playoff series (best 2 out of 3) between the East Division champion and the West Division champion. There will be **TWO** All Star teams picked from the League. One All Star team with only 11 year olds to represent the league in the 11 year old District Tournament to be held in Donaldsonville, Louisiana. One All Star Team of 12 year olds to represent the league in the 12 year old District Tournament to be held in New Roads, Louisiana. No 11 year olds will be allowed to play on the 12 year old team and no 12 year olds will be allowed to play on the 11 year old team.
4. Division playoffs will be held June 17th and 18th , 2004.
5. Each player must play at least one (1) complete innings (6 outs) in each game, and bat at least once in every game.
EXCEPTION: 10-run rule game and/or time limit. In this case player must start next scheduled game.
6. All Star selection of players and coaches will be at the discretion of Iberville Parks and Recreation District.
7. League Tournament will be Saturday, June 5th, 2004 ... single elimination.
8. Anything not covered under the above rules will be decided by IPRD.
